

INTERLOCKING FRACTIONS ACTIVITY

All over the world it is said that teaching and learning of Math becomes more effective when it is fun, especially hands on activities. Hands on activities are engaging and creates interest in the subject. In the past our newsletters have included many hands on activities and here we come again with another interesting activity. One such hands on activity conducted for the students of grade IV was 'INTERLOCKING FRACTIONS'. Fractions are among the most challenging mathematical ideas for students to master. Interlocking Fraction Circles provide students with a model they can manipulate as they discover the parts of a whole, the relationships between fractions, equivalency, and much more. These interlocking circles enable students to explore fractions, fractional equivalences, add and subtract fractions, work with mixed numbers, and more. Students were taught to make these models in one of the Math class. Students made these models and used them to learn the various concepts of fractions. You all too can make these circles and enjoy learning fractions. Here are the few circles made by the students. Have fun while you learn!!!!!!!!!



RAJMA BEAN ACTIVITY

We did the raima bean activity to learn the concept of division. It was so much fun! For that we need some Rajma beans and ice tray, first our teacher, Lalitha ma'am asked us some guestions. For E.g. $12 \div 6 = ?$

For that we need to take 12 rajma beans, divide them into 6 compartments of the ice tray. First put one raima bean in each compartment at a time. Then add one more in each compartment again.
